 ence.

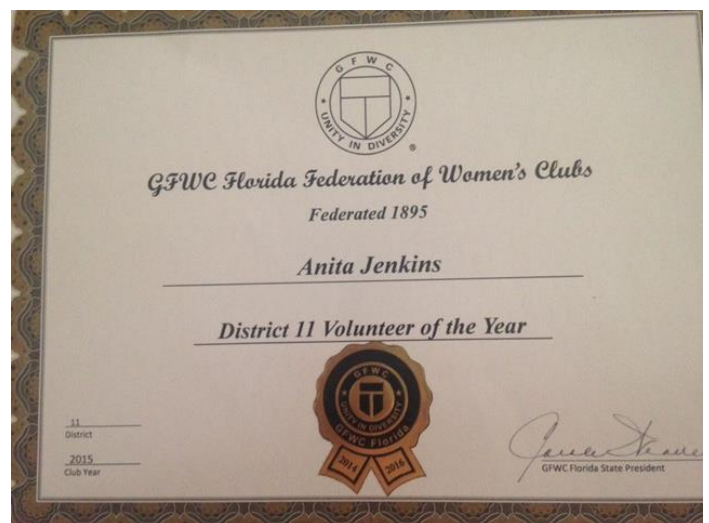
This year was also a change in the administration.

 Year.





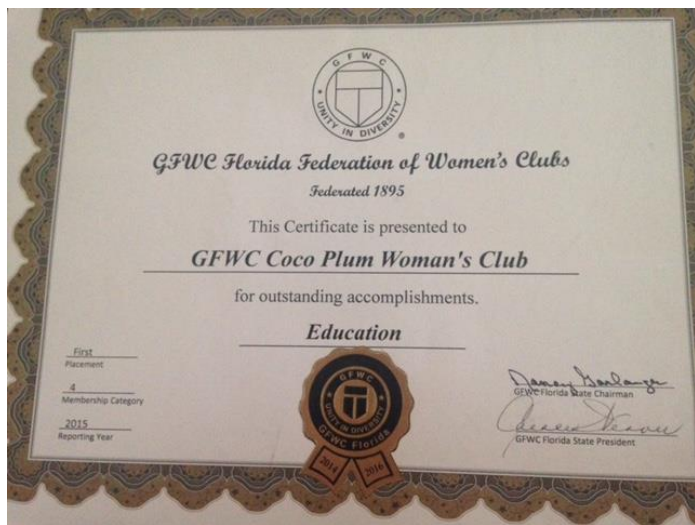
